### Health and Dental

Renegotiated the plan coverage and premiums.

Plan usage overall is up from the previous year.

6% tax on health insurance premiums has been removed by the sask government.

(7743 roughly) Number of students enrolled in the plan and (34%) opt of students opted out are relatively the same as last year, just a slight increase for enrolment.

There is a new late opt out exception tool. Students who miss the opt out date for the health and dental fee can apply through the new tool.
